### Video training sessions

### Introduction to the Cave Languages Schemes of Work

- Aimed at schools who are new to the KS2 or Mixed-Age schemes
- Provides an overview and insight about the content, lesson plans, progression, resources and assessment
- The length of the video is 1 hour 15 minutes

### Introduction to the Phonics Method

- Aimed at anyone new to delivering KS2 or Mixed-Age schemes
- Provides an insight into the actions and images of the kinaesthetic method and how phonics is embedded and taught in the schemes
- The length of the video is 45 minutes

## FRENCH LANGUAGE UPSKILLING

### Video training sessions

#### French Grammar

- For anyone delivering French lessons in primary schools and lacks confidence in knowledge of French grammar
- Suitable for complete beginners or those with 'rusty' language skills
- 1 video for lower KS2 and one for upper KS2
- The length of each video is about 1 hour 15/30 minutes

#### Teaching in Years 3 & 4

- Become more confident about your knowledge of French grammar to teach in Years 3 and 4
- Through interactive and engaging activities, improve your understanding of singular and plural nouns, the indefinite article, the gender of nouns, the position of adjectives, questions, negatives and some high frequency verbs and pronouns

#### Teaching in Years 5 & 6

- Become more confident about your knowledge of French grammar to teach in Years 5 and 6. Prior attendance on the Years 3 and 4 course may be beneficial
- Through interactive and engaging activities, improve your understanding of negative sentences, the position and agreement of adjectives in the singular and plural, the definite article, using verbs and pronouns in complex sentence building

#### French Phonics and Pronunciation

##### French Pronunciation – 1

- Practise the 26 key French sounds using a sound, action, spelling system – Physical French Phonics
- Learn about silent letters and liaison
- Improve the accuracy of your pronunciation
- The length of the video is 1 hour and 30 minutes – interactive activities

##### French Pronunciation – 2

- Become more familiar with the key 26 sounds, silent letters and liaison
- Become more confident about the accuracy of your pronunciation
- Apply phonic knowledge and a step-by-step strategy to decode familiar and unfamiliar words
- The length of the video is 1 hour – interactive activities
